In compliance with the above orders and to help mitigate the spread of the Corona virus post 396 will institute the following steps while open:

- 1. Operating hours will be from 3:00 P.M. 10:00 P.M. Monday through Sunday.
- 2. Admittance will be to Members and one (1) guest only.
- 3. Wearing of a mask is mandatory
- 4. If you have a medical condition that precludes you from wearing a mask, you must declare so when asked.
- 5. Please remain seated at your table, the bartender will come to you.
- 6. You may remove your mask when seated at your table or the bar.
- 7. If you need to leave your table for any reason please wear your mask
- 8. Any person who has symptoms of covid-19, or is sick, should NOT enter the building.
- 9. Please use hand sanitizer when you enter the building and before entering the restrooms.
 - a. There will be 3 hand sanitizer stations located within the building.
- 10. Members and their guests must wear a mask when not seated.
- 11. Total building capacity will be limited to 30 people with an additional 12 people allowed in the outdoor patio area.
- 12. Groups are limited to 10 people or less.
- 13. Single use cups will be available for mixed drinks. Please dispose of all cups in the trash cans after use.
- 14. Do not return empty beer bottles to the serving station. Please put empty beer bottles in boxes provided.
- 15. Patrons will be required to run a tab and pay the tab prior to leaving the building.
- 16. The ventilation system in the club room will be running at all times.
